



## 2018 TANABATA FESTIVAL KAZARI BASIC JUDGING CRITERIA

Originality/Creativity use of flowers and steamers, and Construction.

### REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Saturday, August 4

Kazari not registered by the deadline will not be eligible for the contest and will be displayed only.

**Basic Design:** Utilizing the traditional method (*kusudama* (ball) top, ring in the middle, and streamers).

**Originality/Creativity:** Is the kazari constructed in a way that expands the traditional method?

- Unique design in place of the *kusudama* (ball) alternative shapes and materials are acceptable.
- Your *kazari* must be covered by at least 50% with hand-made paper flowers.
- It must have streamers, which can be made from paper, strings of origami or other items may be included.

**Materials Not Recommended:** light weight items such as foil, ribbon get tangled and fall off

**Suggest:** heavy duty scotch tape, double sided tape and glue or thin wire to support paper flowers.

**If the kazari is over the maximum height, width or weight, it will be disqualified for the contest.**

- **MAXIMUM HEIGHT: 8 feet**
- **MAXIMUM WIDTH: 22 inches**
- **MAXIMUM WEIGHT: 8 pounds**

**PRIZES:** The first place winner in each category will receive \$50 and a specially designed framed award. The Founder's Award will be awarded to the overall winner of the first place winners and receives an additional \$50 prize.
